Day 01 Sigiriya / Dambulla	<p>Arrival FLIGHT - 0330 HRS Arriving in the morning Flight to BIA / Welcome and Greet by Representative Guide, Proceed to Negombo.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Have Breakfast and with rooms to refresh in Negombo at Tamarind tree Hotel or Similar close to the Airport 4* ➤ Proceed to Pinnawela approximately at 08.00 am (Traveling time 02 HRS) <p><u>Pinnawela Elephant Orphanage</u></p> <p>A captive breeding and conservation institute for wild Asian elephants located at Pinnawala village, Pinnawala has the largest herd of captive elephants in the world.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Proceed to Dambulla or Sigiriya approximately at 1.30 PM (Traveling time 02.30 HRS) <p><u>Check in to the hotel at Sigiriya or Dambulla 4*/5*</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Evening Visit Sigiriya Lion Rock approximately at 4.00 PM <p>King Kashyapa (AD 477–495) built his palace on top of this rock and decorated its sides with colorful frescoes. On a small plateau about halfway up the side of this rock he built a gateway in the form of an enormous lion. Day 02 Sigiriya / Dambulla	<p>➤ After Breakfast Proceed to Village Tour approximately at 0900 HRS</p> <p><u>Village Tour Safari</u></p> <p>Walk Through the Traditional Sri Lankan Paddy Fields, Catamaran Ride, Bullock Cart Ride, The Tree House, Experience Local Food, it offers the best experience of Local Village</p> <p>➤ Proceed to Minneriya or Echo Park approximately at 1500 HRS</p> <p><u>Minneriya National Park or Echo Park</u></p> <p>The tank is of historical importance, having been built by King Mahasen in third century AD. The park is a dry season feeding ground for the elephant population dwelling in forests of Matale, Polonnaruwa, and Trincomalee districts. Also Ideal Local to Spot Leopards. And many Sri Lankan Endemic Species. Minneriya National Park is the World's Largest gathering of Wild Elephants.</p> <p><u>Dinner and overnight Stay in Sigiriya / Dambulla – 4*/ 5*</u></p>	Hotel - Sigiriya/ Dambulla - 4*/ 5*	B- D
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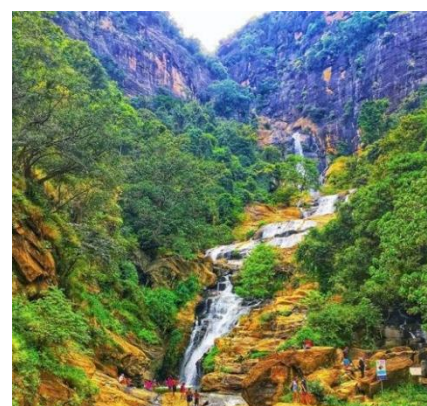
Day 03 Kandy	<p>➤ After Breakfast proceed to Kandy approximately 0800 HRS (Traveling Time 2 HRS)</p> <p><u>En route visit Matale Spice Garden</u></p> <p>For centuries, spices have been one of the most celebrated exports in Sri Lanka. They have been used for medicines, cosmetics as well as to flavor foods. History says that the Greeks, Arabs & Malays had linked with Sri Lankan business field through spice trade.</p> <p><u>Then Proceed to Kandy – Kandy City Tour</u></p> <p>Kandy, pronounced is a major city in Sri Lanka located in the Central Province. It was the last capital of the ancient kings' era of Sri Lanka. The city is situated in the midst of hills in the Kandy plateau, which crosses an area of tropical plantations, mainly tea. Kandy is both an administrative and religious city and is also the capital of the Central Province.</p> <p><u>Visit Peradeniya Botanical Garden</u></p> <p>It is renowned for its collection of orchids. The garden includes more than 4000 species of plants, including orchids, spices, medicinal plants and palm trees.</p> <p>➤ Visit Gem Museum ➤ Visit Cultural Show</p>	Hotel - Kandy - 4*/5*	B - D
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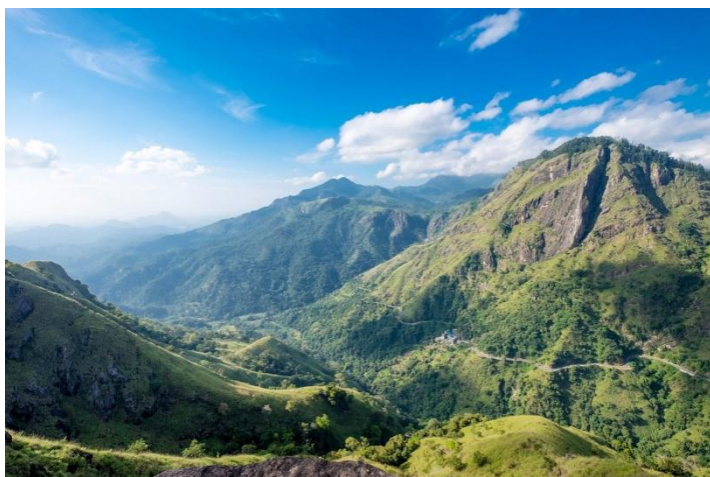

Nuwara Eliya	<p><u>Proceed to Nuwara Eliya / City tour</u></p> <p>With the Colonial Touch, picturesque landscape and temperate climate. It is at an altitude of 1,868 m (6,128 ft) and is considered to be the most important location for tea production in Sri Lanka. The city is overlooked by Pidurutalagala, the tallest mountain in Sri Lanka. Nuwara Eliya is known for its temperate, cool climate – the coolest area in Sri Lanka.</p> <p><u>Gregory Lake</u></p> <p>Lake Gregory was constructed in the year 1873. Also known by the name Gregory Lake, it is a wetland converted into a beautiful lake. Used for recreational purposes, the lake is visited by large number of tourists every year. The lake is located in the heart of the city. And has now converted into a lake park where one can enjoy relaxing picnics. Spend quality time with your family here as it is one of the top picnic spots.</p> <p><u>Dinner and overnight in Nuwara Eliya – 4*/5*</u></p>		




Day 05 ELLA	<p>➤ After Breakfast Proceed to Ella approximately at 0900 HRS Via Tea Train (Traveling Time 04 HRS)</p> <p>➤ Visit Nine Arch Bridge</p> <p>The Nine Arch Bridge, known as the "Bridge in the Sky," is a must-see attraction in Ella. This bridge is a magnificent piece of engineering and offers stunning views of the surroundings. You will pass this bridge when arriving at Ella. You can also visit the bridge to get a closer look or visit a higher spot for a better view and some great photos. Constructed in the British colonial era in the early 20th century, the bridge is made of stone, bricks, and cement without the use of steel.</p> <p>➤ Ravana Falls</p> <p>This waterfall measures approximately 25 m (82 ft) in height and cascades from an oval-shaped concave rock outcrop. During the local wet season, the waterfall turns into what is said to resemble an area flower with withering petals. But this is not the case in the dry season, where the flow of water reduces dramatically. The falls form part of the Ravana Ella Wildlife Sanctuary, and is located 6 km (3.7 mi) away from the local railway station at Ella.</p> <p>Proceed to Hotel and Check in</p> <p><u>Dinner and overnight in Ella Hotel 4*</u></p>	Hotel - Ella 4*	B - D
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Day 06 YALA	<p>➤ After Breakfast Proceed to Yala approximately at 0900 HRS (Traveling Time 03 HRS)</p> <p>➤ En Route Visit Little Adams Peak</p> <p>Little Adam's Peak, also known as "Mini Adam's Peak" or "Punchi Sri Pada," is a popular hiking spot in Ella. The hike is relatively easy and offers gorgeous views of the surrounding hills and valleys, including the famous Ella Rock, the Nine Arch Bridge, and the town of Ella. Little Adam's peak is actually made up of 3 separate summits, and the hike to the third one is somewhat of a challenge.</p> <p>➤ Visit Tissa Lake</p> <p>Tissa Wewa is a reservoir in Tissamaharama, thought to have been constructed in the 3rd century BC, either by Mahanaga of Ruhuna or his successor Yatala Tissa of Ruhuna, in order to irrigate paddy lands and supply water to the flourishing city of Tissamaharama. The lake was restored in 1871</p> <p>Proceed to Hotel and Check in</p> <p><u>Dinner and overnight in Yala Hotel 4*/ 5*</u></p>	Hotel - Yala 4*/5*	B - D
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Day 07 COLOMBO	<p>➤ After Breakfast Proceed to Yala Safari approximately at 0600 HRS</p> <p><u>Yala Safari</u></p> <p>Yala National Park is the most popular wildlife destination in Sri Lanka because of the high chance of encounter and variety of animals. Its diversity of bird, mammal and reptile life is unrivalled in the country and there are particularly high densities of its two keystone species: elephants and leopards.</p>  <p><u>Then Proceed to Colombo Evening Colombo City tour</u></p> <p>Colombo is the executive and judicial capital and largest city of Sri Lanka by population. According to the Brookings Institution, the Colombo metropolitan area has a population of 5.6 million, It is the financial center of the island and a tourist destination.</p> <p>BMICH/ Galle Face Green/ Old Parliament/ Torrington Square/ Gangaramaya/Pettah Market/ Colonial Buildings – will be some of the Locations visited</p> <p>➤ Visit One Galle Face Shopping Mall</p> <p>Proceed to Hotel and Check in</p> <p><u>Dinner and overnight in Colombo Hotel 5*</u></p>	Hotel - Colombo 5*	B - D
